

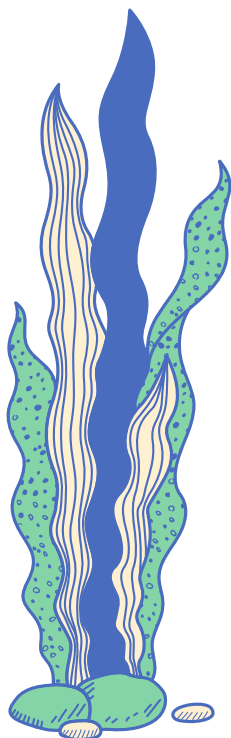
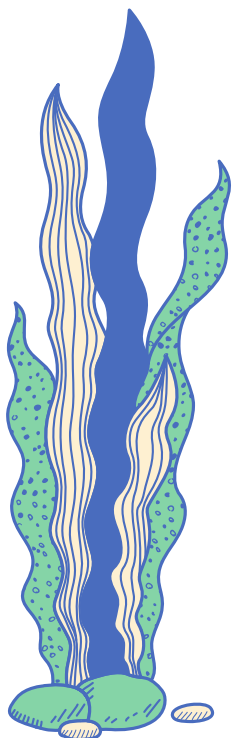


# Marine Pollution

We can talk about marine pollution when industrial, agricultural and residential waste, particles, noise, excess carbon dioxide or invasive organisms substances used or spread by humans.



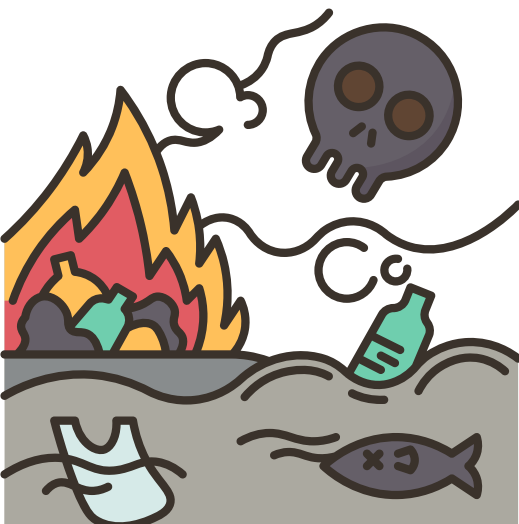

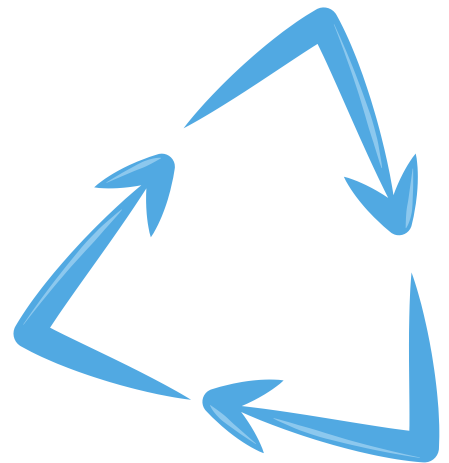
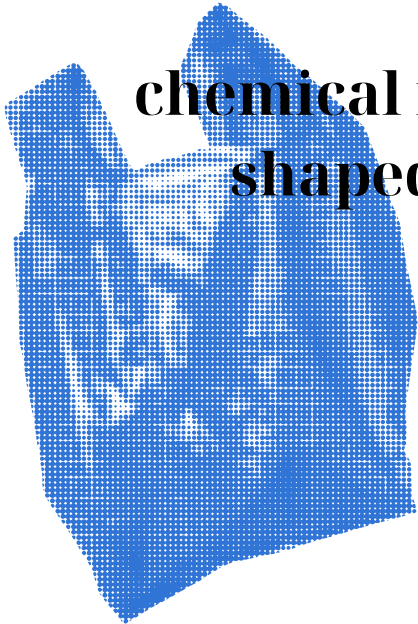


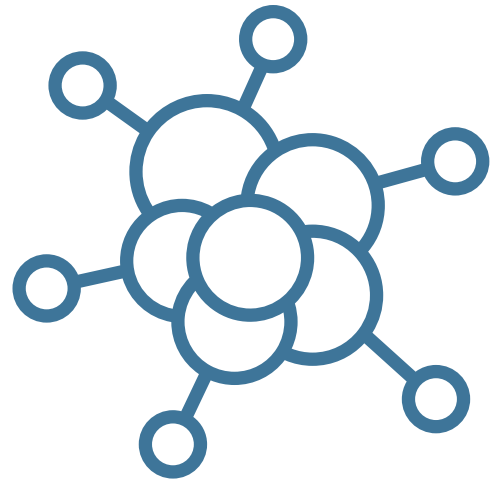
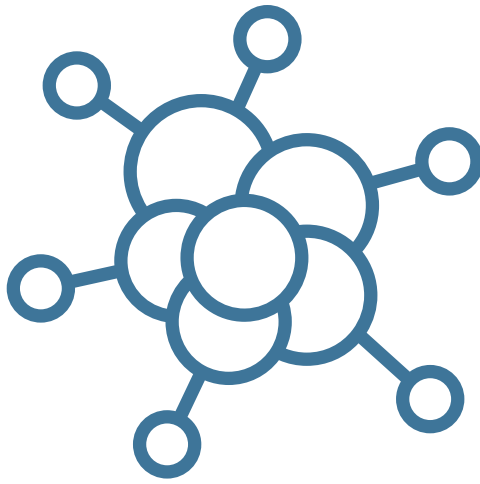
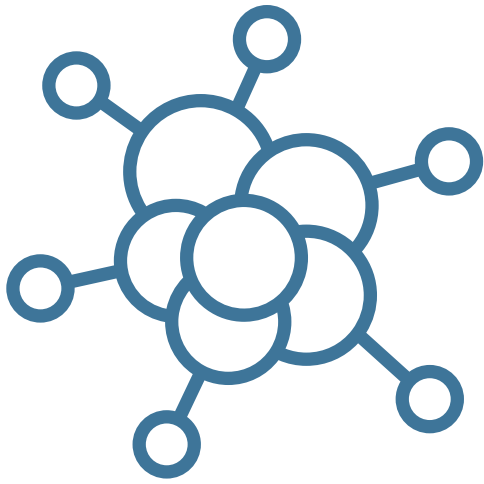
# Plastic

temperature.**





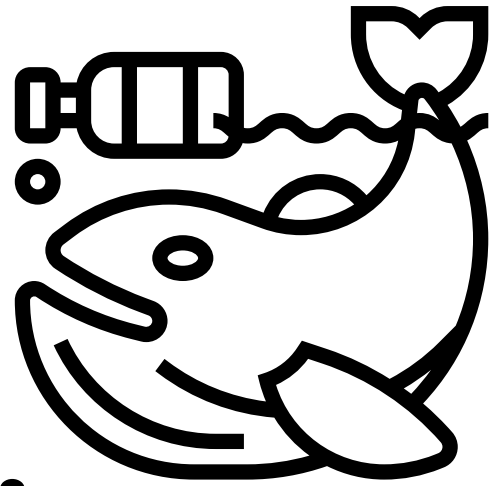
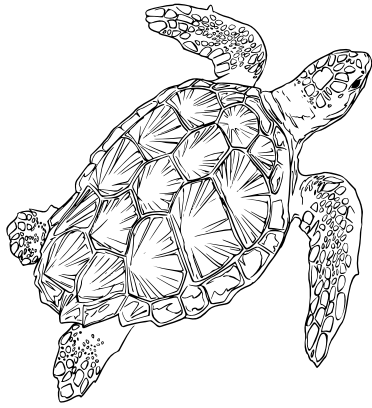
